Throughout the track, Amy paints a telling picture of her <u>tempestuous</u> relationship with her man. Even though she exhibits warning signs of her bad behaviour and <u>precarious</u> lifestyle of substance abuse and cheating, her man still takes her back and looks past all her damaging actions.
